Message from our President

We thank God because last August 2021, He allowed us to incorporate FUNDACION AMOR, GRACIA Y PAN (AGaP) which was established with the purpose of bringing the Word of God to the village of Granizal, where we seek to impact:

- Children from 0 to 12 years old.
- Teenagers from 13 to 18 years old.
- Moms of all ages.

During the three Saturday of each month when we visited we gave:

- More than 3,000 lunches.
- Around 150 basic food bags.

And held 3 bazaars created to reward everyone's attendance With "BAZAR-PUNTOS" which are points given to reward people who faithfully attend, participate and collaborate they can buy new and donated clothing.



We had financial donations and our volunteer staff reached 20 people, allowing us to carry out other activities that were not planned but thanks to the resources received benefited the community:

- Bible Day
- The birth of Christ, where more than 180 kids outfits and gifts were delivered in a special celebration. Additionally, a dinner was provided to 23 families on Christmas Day.

All the founding partners were very surprised and grateful for all the support and resources received, both human and financial.

**What did we do
in 2021??**

A bible based learning program with children and teenagers

This program is being carried out in the village of Granizal-Bello, Antioquia, one of the largest settlements of displaced people in the country. It is a village that is marred by social and economic difficulties crowded by Colombian families displaced by the internal war and Venezuelan migrants.

At the end of 2021, we have approximately 190 children and teenagers who are summoned on Saturdays at two different times: 8:30 and 10:45 am; in order to distribute the activities as follows: During the first 45 minutes the bible teaching is given, the next 15 minutes a lunch is provided, and the following hour they are divided into five tables (preschool, first-third, fourth-sixth, seventh-ninth, tenth-eleventh) for homework support.





Teach children and teenagers about the word of God.

Objectives

Motivate children and teenagers to continue their studies at school.



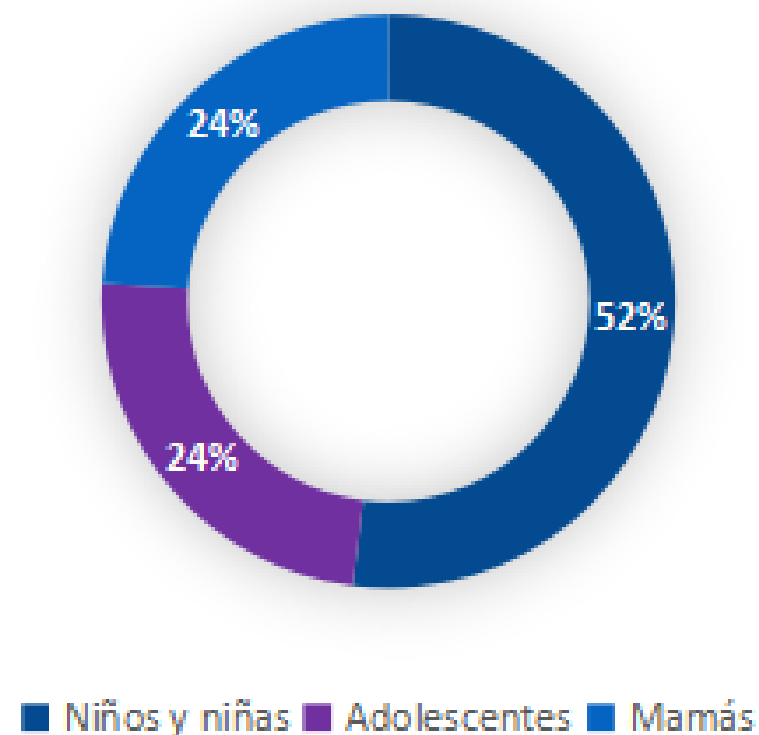
Provide academic support, advising children and teenagers on their homework or school topics.

Reach

There were 190 children and teenagers between 3 and 18 years old, who were taught about different Bible stories. Due to the growth in the number of attendees, the groups were divided into two age groups: 3-11 years old and 12-18 years old. For the 3-11 year old group they were taught about different Bible stories including the story of David, the story of Jesus and salvation, the prodigal son and a series of 8 lessons in which they were shown God as Abba father. For the teen group (12-18 years old) the topics were: creation, original design and our value in Christ.

Regarding the educational approach, the children and teenagers were accompanied in the development of their school study guides during the academic period in which they had to remain at home due to the pandemic. In subjects related to Math, Social Sciences, Biology, Spanish, and English, we used Christian and educational books in which school reinforcement activities were carried out with a Christian approach; likewise, we worked with some children and teenagers on their reading and writing skills, since we found that a couple of them did not know how to read or write, due to the socio-cultural situation and because of the pandemic they fell behind in these processes. Some of them were able to advance in some academic areas.

2021 Programs

Bible Day Celebration

This celebration was held in the month of October, and all our activity was based on the importance of the Bible and how it can help us to get closer to God.

Christmas celebration

This activity was carried out in the month of December, with the intention that each child and teenager had a Christmas gift, that included a toy and an outfit. For this activity, a donation and sponsorship campaign was carried out to collect these gifts, and thanks to this, 180 gifts were distributed.



Women's program

Our main objective is to achieve social transformation through the promotion of values of respect and love based on a relationship with Jesus. Our women's program is directed to the mothers of our children, these activities are focused in a practical way, where they can learn about the love and grace of Jesus through crafts, games, and the study of the word of God.

In 2021, two series were developed called:

- Encounters: where women analyzed biblical stories of women who had a personal and transforming encounter with God, highlighting their value as women.
- The freedom of forgiveness: they were taught the importance of forgiveness and inner healing.



Food Donations



Basic food bags

Throughout the year, basic food bags were donated to the families of our programs. In December, 80 basic food bags were distributed, thanks to a donation from the "Reincorporated" foundation.



Christmas meal

23 families (120 people) were impacted with a Christmas dinner to share a special meal on December 24, at a cost of approximately 500,000 COP.
